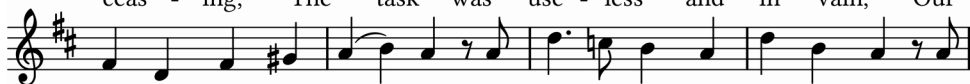

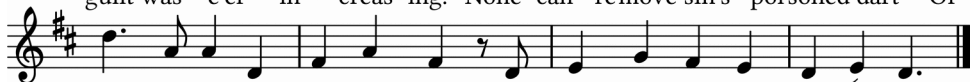

**HYMN OF THE DAY: Salvation unto Us Has Come (vv. 7–14)**
